Police Officers Donovan and Harris updated the Council on the Town's crime figures for March, there were 15 reported thefts and 22 reports of violence. The main focus for the local Officers was off road biking and that CCBC had now taken over onstreet car parking enforcement. Mr Jay Haines of the local drama group Risca Cuckoos highlighted his concerns for his group's finances. The Clerk is to forward the Town's application forms for financial assistance to Mr Haines for his group to consider. Mrs Davies of the Senior Citizens Hall gave the Council a summary of the ongoing and expected hall improvements to add to their submission for financial assistance - the Council will consider the submission.
