The current statements are satisfactory. The Council considered the Clerk's budget report and the Town's Band D community charge options report for 2018/2019, in line with the Council's current, three year business plan. After a detailed discussion, the Council agreed a slightly reduced budget from the three year plan and decided to raise the Band D charge from its current figure of £18.10 per year to £18.70 for 2018/2019. This would raise an approximate amount of £1000 in income from the community charge which is in line with the Central Government's 3% inflation mark
