# 513.4 Correspondence/financial assistance applications –

The Mayor advised that following the sudden death form sepsis (blood poisoning), of a local 16 year old girl from Rogerstone with family connections in Risca that a local charity was formed called the Lucy Ellis Foundation. The Mayor asked the Council to consider a donation to the new charity that has a view to funding a new ECMO machine for South East Wales to assist with the early detection of the deadly condition. The Council agreed that an on line banking donation of £500 be made to the Foundation. The Council also agreed to consider options for a series of music events in late 2018 and early 2019 to raise more funding for the Foundation. The Clerk is to investigate suitable local venues for music evenings. The Clerk is to pursue with CCBC Parks if a new flagpole is feasible in the Pontymister Memorial Gardens to fly the Red Ensign on 3 September. The Clerk is investigating a new Instagram account and a suitable venue to hold a public participation exercise in the autumn
