683.3 Correspondence/financial assistance applications

The Council re-considered the October meeting request from CCBC for funding for their summer sport scheme for activities at Risca Leisure Centre over the six week summer holidays of 2020 and again decided to defer any decision on this until later in 2020. The Council are still awaiting the submission from Fusion Dance. The Clerk reported that the planned date for the April Council meeting was set for Monday 13 April but as this is the Easter Bank Holiday Monday the Council agreed to postpone that meeting to Monday 20 April. The Clerk is to attend at CCBC offices for training on a replacement Council website in early March. The Clerk reported that he had an email from CCBC informing him that CCBC will NOT be holding a Risca Summer Fair this year. Instead CCBC are holding a week long Beach Party in Tredegar Park from 23 to 31 May with no involvement allowed by the Town Council. Also, no marguees or stalls will be allowed. The Council wished to note their great disappointment at the news that the Summer Fair is not to take place this year. The Council agreed to give greater consideration to the VE Europe weekend and asked the Clerk to write to CCBC for permission to hold a project in the Park on Sat 9 May as part of that weekend's events. The Council agreed for the Clerk to meet with the CCBC
