178 Mayor's Announcement

Cllr Tom advised the meeting that he attended the Oxford House presentation evening but was unable to attend the Newbridge Armed Forces Parade last

month. Cllr Tom commented on the success of both The Bands in the Park and the Summer Fayre recent events in the town. He added that we are to seek permission from Caerphilly Council for a larger marquee for next year's Fayre.

Cllr Tom signed the minutes as a true and correct record.

180 County Members' updates

Cllr Phyllis Griffiths reported on a pending six week review of the Risca Flood Defence Project from the Environment Agency, the site of the old library could be used for housing land, maybe a youth club at the old Baths site and possibly for the future a community centre upstairs at the Oxford House site via a Welsh Office grant. Cllr Griffiths added that trees were removed recently due to the river bank works in readiness for the flood defence scheme. Cllr Tom asked about the recent removal by Caerphilly Council of the future funding for Christmas festive lighting in Risca Town centre. Investigations are needed to seek where the Traders' owned 32 festive figurines are stored for possible reuse this year and the overall costings of this annual public service that the Town Council is expected to fund.

181.1 Notice Boards

Three new smaller boards are stored with Cllr Tom and locations had been found and agreed. Caerphilly Highways had been asked to provide a cost estimate for the associated Civil Engineering works. Cllr Hancock is to contact a local builder for advice on the replacement for the Chemist frontage board

The second invoice from Caerphilly Parks for £156.31 was discussed at the Joint meeting on 2 July. The outcome decided upon was not to agree to the additional charge for the use of a lorry and 2 operatives that was miscalculated
