Cllr Brian Hancock reported that the Council may receive an invoice from Caerphilly county borough council for £800 towards the printing and advertising costs of the recent Local Government election notices. The Chair and Vice-Chair are to speak directly to HSBC Bank over the length of time it has taken to change the name on the Council's accounts and to issue new chequebooks in the name of Risca Town Council
