2/ John Brimble, a local resident, presented his report on the historical and possibly current issues he had encountered at Carno Reservoir and Dam that is located near Tredegar and Rhymney at the Heads of the Valleys. His investigations highlighted that historical Ebbw River flooding in Risca, particularly in 1979, may have been due to those Carno issues. The Council agreed for the Clerk to contact Natural Resources Wales and Dwr Cymru/Welsh Water to express its concern for any future flooding in Risca
