#### 863.1 Finance Report

The Clerk reported his monthly account summary to date and the Council agreed the report as satisfactory. The Clerk reported that he had still not received any news yet on the 2020/2021 Audit Return from Audit Wales and that he has presented the 2021/2022 half year audit to the internal auditor

#### 863.2 One Voice Wales/CCBC/WG/SLCC/TCCLC

The Clerk and Cllr Mike Parker attended the Caerphilly TCCLC virtual meeting on Wed 20 October. The next TCCLC virtual Joint meeting with CCBC Cllrs is set for Wed 24 November. OVW continue to recommend that councils hold meetings in a virtual format until the health crisis abates. The Town Council will continue to hold virtual meetings unless otherwise advised by Welsh Government and One Voice Wales

#### 863.3 Correspondence

1/ The Council were made aware that Caerphilly County Borough Council had still not responded to provide a detailed cost estimate of an electrical supply to be located into both memorial gardens in the Town and the additional request from Risca RBL for a water supply at Pontymister Gardens 2/ Cllr Ffion Green reported on a request she had received to consider removing an overhanging tree from Risca Primary School's grounds. The Council noted that Cllr Green will be in contact with the School to deal with the request and will make a further report on the issue as discussions continue 3/ The Council discussed a replacement location for their Defibrillator that was previously housed in the Exchange Post Office. The Chair will contact the local Fusion Dance Group to see if they will house the equipment 4/ The Clerk was pleased to report that Caerphilly county borough council had agreed to carry out the necessary road closures and provide public indemnity insurance for an Armistice/Remembrance Parade through Risca Town on Sunday 14 Nov 2021. The Clerk confirmed that on Friday 22nd October he had acted as the event 'local organiser 'and had completed and submitted to CCBC their road closures application form on behalf of Risca Town Council. The Town Council were very pleased to hear that a Remembrance Parade in the

Town was now able to take place in 2021. The Clerk reported on a submitted written summary of the planned Armistice week events by Steve Veysey of Risca RBL. The Council agreed to donate a maximum of £300 to Risca RBL towards their Remembrance Sunday parade's buffet and programmes cost 5/ The Clerk reported that a financial assistance request had been received from The Brightwell in Bradley Stoke in South West England which is an independent charity which offers treatments, therapies and support to individuals living with Multiple Sclerosis (MS). The request applicant added that they were assisting a Risca Town resident. The Council agreed for the Clerk to send the applicant the Town's financial assistance forms for their further consideration
