#### 878 Presentations

Moriah Church Pastor, Marc Owen addressed the Council to provide an update on the Tredegar Park toilet block. Pastor Owen reported that the toilet block was open to the public for most of 2021 for six days of the week (when allowed by the Govt) except for the Christmas holiday week. He added there had been some vandalism at the block that had been attended to and he was grateful to the Town Council and East Community Council for their continued financial support. He will provide an updated report in May 2022 to include the toilet block's forecasted finances for the 2022/2023 financial year.

Steve Veysey of Risca RBL asked if the Council and the Town Clerk would apply to CCBC for an Armistice/Remembrance parade through the Town in 2022. The Clerk agreed that he would take this role on, providing CCBC again provide the necessary road closures and the public indemnity insurance associated with a parade. Steve also reported that the Risca RBL Branch intended to celebrate the 40 years anniversary of the end of the Falklands War on 14<sup>th</sup> of July 2022
