893.1 Finance Report

The Clerk advised the Council that Caerphilly CBC had called a new Risca Town Centre Management Group virtual meeting for 8.30 am on Tues 22 Feb and asked if as many Town Cllrs could attend as possible

893.3 Correspondence

- 1/ The Clerk reported that on Tues 8 Feb 2022 together with Cllrs Mike Parker and Sally Davies they had met with Risca RBL officers and the Caerphilly CBC Street Lighting Engineer to discuss the provision and a detailed cost estimate of an electrical supply to be located into both memorial gardens in the Town 2/ The Clerk is still to arrange for a new defibrillator and outside housing box for the local Fusion Dance Group. Further information on a possible power supply to the box is being discussed with the Dance Group
- 3/ The Clerk is to continue to investigate replacements for the Councils town centre notice boards
- 4/ The Council agreed for Cllrs S Davies, J Parsons and L Stephens to make up a Queen's Platinum Jubilee event sub-group. The summer event is to take place in Tredegar Park on Sun 5 June 2022. The Clerk confirmed that he had already sought and received permission for the event in the Park from Caerphilly CBC Parks Department
- 5/ The Clerk and the Mayor Cllr Mike Parker confirmed that the 'Risca Tots' group could not satisfy the Council's financial assistance terms and the Mayor is to consider making a separate donation to the tots group from his personal annual allowance
- 6/ The Clerk reported that he is still in discussion with Caerphilly CBC Libraries to take out a new rental agreement for the hire of the Library office for Risca Town Council's use. He added that as the health crisis restrictions are being eased he hoped that the Council could resume meeting indoors in person on Monday evening 14 March at the Bethany Church Hall
- 7/ The Clerk also advised the Council of the coming Local Elections date of Thurs 5 May 2022. The Elections are for all Local Authorities in Cymru/Wales to include Risca Town Council's 8 seats for the next 5 years
