The meeting was held as a 'hybrid meeting', thus it was open as an inperson, indoors meeting at the Bethany Church Hall and as a remote virtual meeting on Monday 13 June 2022

928 Presentations

The Mayor/Chair Cllr Sally Davies welcomed back Mike Parker as a co-opted Member of the Town Council. Cllr Davies also reported on the great success of the Town Council's Queen's Jubilee Summer Fair and the 'Lighting of the Beacon' event on Twmbarlwm mountain. Cllr Davies wished to record her thanks to all the Town Cllrs and their friends and families who helped with the workload of the Summer Fair, making it such a success for the residents of Risca.

Moriah Church Pastor Marc Owen gave the Council a resume of his Church's management of the Tredegar Park's Toilet Block. Despite a number of disappointing vandalism incidents, his local charity has been able to open the toilet block Monday-Saturday over the past year. He asked the Town Council for a further contribution of £3500 to the running costs for 2022/2023. The Council wished to note their appreciation for all the hard work the Pastor and his colleagues had made to keep the block open.

The Risca RBL representative Steve Veysey reported that he is in discussions with the two Caerphilly County Cllrs over funding towards the quote from Western Power for new power supplies to both Memorial Gardens. He added that he will also approach the three Caerphilly County Cllrs at Risca East for possible funding. The Council is still pursuing the Risca RBL's other requests for a water supply at Pontymister Gardens and a new flagpole at the Darren Gardens, both to be funded jointly with Risca East. Steve thanked both Town and East Councils for their donations to the successful Risca RBL's Falklands War commemoration concert that was held recently at Moriah Church

- a payment of £3500 to the Moriah Church charity as the Town's donation towards the running costs of the Tredegar Park Toilet block for 2022/2023
