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G2 Correspondence/financial assistance applications

The Council considered a few recently raised complaints: concern that there is no lighting in the new Commercial Street car park for local business staff working into the darkness, drainage issues at the St Mary Street car wash establishment and that the removed footway boundary wall has not been replaced, weeds are not cut out from the local footways and some sandbags are still not removed, The Council are aware that repair work has started at Stony Bridge and that CCBC are to resurface Maryland Street later this year.
